This year's theme, "***Celebrating Our Urban Villages***" will focus on efforts which reflect a commitment to the value of our distinct neighborhoods and districts which through their number, variety, human scale, sense of community, ability to inspire civic and social engagement, and sense of place underlie the positive character of our city, and enhance the quality of experience for residents and visitors. While the existence of these distinct areas has been consistently identified as one of the defining characteristics of San Francisco and an aspect which makes it a place people want to be, they remain under threat from insensitive development, insufficiently wise public policies or conflicting desires for centralization, economies of scale and trends toward uniformity.
